

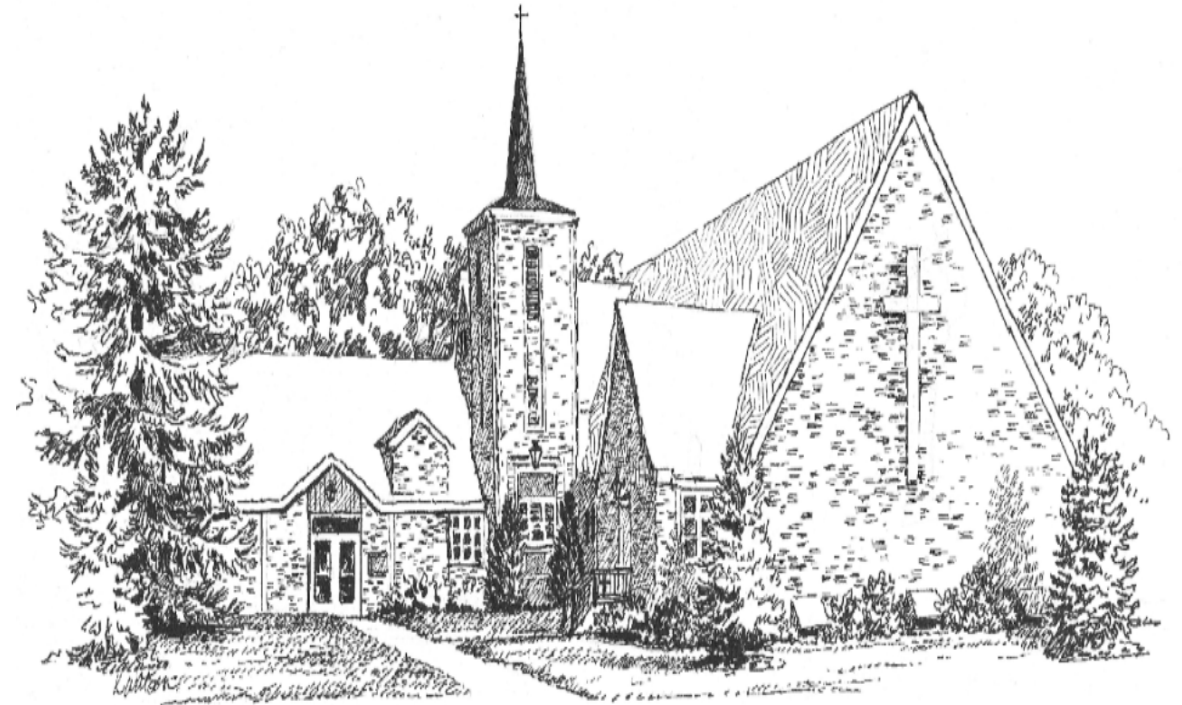
***OFFERTORY PRAYER**
